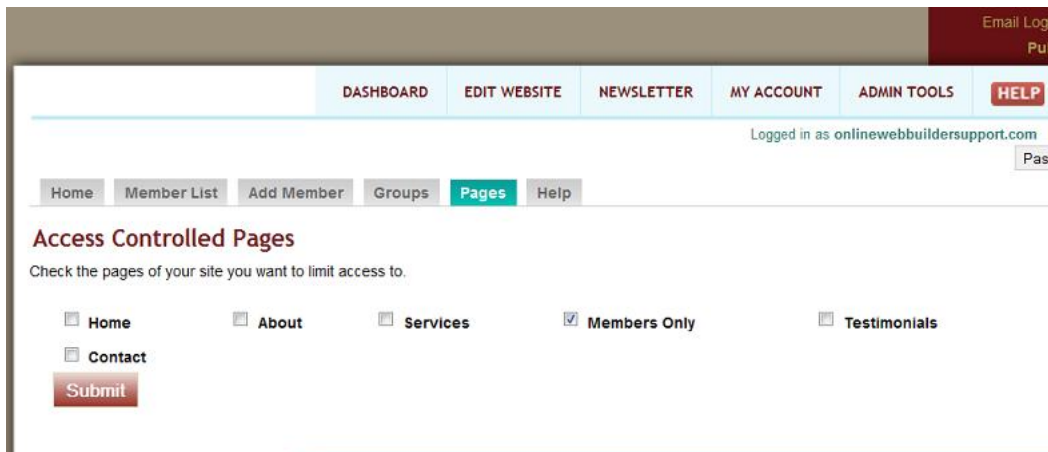


Password Protected Pages: How do I secure a page that will become password protected for members only?

1. Click on Page Access on your Dashboard
2. Select the Pages Tab
3. Check the Page you would like to secure. (*For Example Members Only)
4. Submit your Changes
